



RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMPETITION

„Get to Sziget”

(further: „**Regulations**”)

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1.1. The administrator of the "Get to Sziget" competition, hereinafter referred to as the "Competition" is CHILL ARMADA MACIEJ URBAŃCZYK, NIP 6431647123 with a registered office at Chłodna 48/154 street, 00-872 Warsaw, (hereinafter the "Administrator").

1.2. The competition is taking place on the territory of the Republic of Poland, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Slovenia, Romania, Bulgaria and Macedonia.

1.3. The law applicable to the competition is Polish law.

1.4. The administrator is promising the reward within the meaning of art. 919 and 921 of the Polish Civil Code.

1.5. The sponsor of the competition and the principal is ORBIS S.A. with a registered office in Warsaw, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000022622.

1.6. During the Competition, referred to in point 2 of the Regulations, the content of the Regulations will be available for inspection: on the website at www.ibis.com/gettosziget and at the Administrator's office. All advertising and information materials related to the Competition will be available during the Competition, as referred to in point. 2 of the Regulations, available for inspection at the Administrator's office.

The Administrator declares that the Competition is in no way sponsored, supported, carried out by the entities managing or owning the Facebook portal or linked to them, and the Facebook portal is not liable to participants in connection with the Competition.

2. DURATION OF THE COMPETITION

The competition takes place from May 9 2018 (from 12:00 CET) to June 17 2018 23:59 CET (hereinafter: "Period of Competition duration").

3. CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

3.1 Only adults can participate in the Contest in the manner described in point 3.3. below, natural persons with full legal capacity, residing in the territory of the Republic of Poland, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Slovenia, Romania,

Bulgaria and Macedonia - consumers within the meaning of art. 221 of the Civil Code (hereinafter: "Participants").

3.2 Participants can enter the competition individually (Individual application), or in two or three-person groups of friends (Group application). In the case of group entries, the applicants designate the team captain.

3.3 Administrator's employees, ORBIS S.A. employees are excluded from participation in the Competition, as well as the immediate family members of these employees. By family members it is implied : the ascendants, descendants, siblings, and spouses. Participation in the Competition is voluntary.

3.4 To participate in the Competition, the Participant (or Participants) should meet the following conditions jointly:

A. be an adult;

B. plan a route through selected 7 out of 25 cities of Eastern Europe (with ibis hotels, ibis Styles, ibis budget), the finale of which is the Sziget Festival in Budapest from 8 - 15 August 2018. Stops - cities will be chosen from among a list located on the internet platform at www.ibis.com/gettosziget.

C. record and post a video on YouTube, which will convince the audience that she/he should be chosen. The film, via the competition application form, is attached to the route designed by the participant, no later than by the end of the Contest Period.

3.5 The film included in the Competition must be original and not infringe upon the rights of third parties. It cannot display offensive, obscene, xenophobic, racist, propaganda of fascism, nazism, communism and other totalitarian systems, call for racial hatred, ideological hatred or be discriminatory in any other way, based on sex, race, disability, sexual orientation or ethnicity or violate good customs in any way.

3.6 The administrator reserves the right to exclude a film and participant from the competition without stating a reason.

3.7 The movies of all the participants will be visible on the internet platform at www.ibis.com/gettosziget. The audience votes for the best films by clicking it. You can cast no more than one vote per participant. It is allowed to vote for more than one participant.

3.8 Upon uploading the film and sending the competition form, the Participant grants free consent for the use of its image for public distribution via the Internet, reproduction and recording by any technique, with the right to grant sub-licenses. The consent is granted for an indefinite period, on the territory of the Republic of Poland and the states belonging to the European Union.

3.9 Upon uploading the film and sending the competition form, the Participant transfers copyright to the Administrator to the created audiovisual work on the following fields of exploitation: introduction to computer networks, including the Internet, distribution, duplication, public broadcasting, sharing so that everyone can become familiar with its content in a place and time chosen by themselves.

3.10 After the voting process is finished, out of the 20 people who get the highest number of votes, the jury will choose 10 people and invite them to the finals. The criteria for choosing the final ten will be the creativity of the uploaded movie.

3.11 In the case of qualifying a Group Application for the final, the team captain will be invited to the final.

3.12 Finalists will participate in competition tasks that will take place on the 23rd and 24th of June 2018 (Saturday and Sunday) in Warsaw.

3.13 The costs of transit of the finalists to Warsaw shall be borne by the Administrator. The costs covered by the Administrator include: costs of an air ticket to Warsaw from the Finalist's country of residence, transfer to and from the airport, and accommodation and meals in Warsaw on 23 and 24 June 2018.

3.14 Out of the finalists, the Competition Jury will select 3 people who will receive the Prize.

4. PRIZES

4.1. The following prizes are going to be awarded in the Competition:

A. 3 (in words: three) equivalent main prizes (hereinafter: "Main Prize") with a total value of 11,111 (say: eleven thousand one hundred eleven zlotys and 00/100) grosz zlotys, including:

- Tour around the route chosen by the Administrator in Europe in cities located in Poland, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Slovenia, Romania, Bulgaria, Macedonia and stay at the Sziget Festival in Budapest on August 8 - 15 2018.

4.2 The laureates of the Main Prizes are called the "Laureate" or jointly the "Laureates".

4.3 Main prizes may be awarded to three individual participants, one individual participant and two-person team or one three-person team.

4.4 In the case of group applications, each team member receives an individual main prize and is treated as an independent winner. In the case of group entries, the prize pool does not change.

4.5 The winners are not entitled to request replacement of the Prize in cash or another type of prize.

4.6 Winners cannot transfer the right to designate the Prize to third parties.

4.7 In the case of Laureates with a Polish tax residence, the Administrator will transfer the amount of the cash benefit specified in point 4.1 letter A above to the competent Tax Office as a flat-rate income tax, referred to in art. 30 paragraph 1 point 2 of the Personal Income Tax Act of July 26, 1991.

4.8 In the case of winners who do not have a Polish tax residence, the cash benefit will be paid in cash as the equivalent in Euro, according to the average exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland on the day of payment of the benefit.

The condition for the payment is the submission of Laureate's written statement about his/hers tax residence.

4.9 As part of the Main Prize, the Administrator provides food, transport, accommodation as well as admission to the Sziget Festival in Budapest from 8th to 15th August 2018.

4.10 Accommodation as a part of the Prize will take place at ibis, ibis Styles, ibis budget hotels in Poland, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Slovenia, Romania, Bulgaria and Macedonia.

5. SELECTING WINNERS AND ISSUING PRIZES IN THE COMPETITION

5.1 In order to select the winners and in order to ensure the supervision of the proper course of the Competition, the Administrator will appoint a five-person Competition Jury (hereinafter: "Jury"). The place of the Committee's proceedings is the headquarters of the Administrator. The jury makes decisions by a simple majority of votes cast. A report will be drawn up by the Committee concerning the vote.

5.2 The finalists will be informed about the qualification to the Final by e-mail or by phone to the e-mail address or phone provided by the participant in the Competition Form. In the case of Group entries qualifying for the Final, the Team Captain will be notified.

5.3 The winners of the Main Prize will be notified of the win in person on the day of the Final.

5.4 The trip will take place by a means of transport provided by the Administrator. All Laureates will depart from the place indicated by the Administrator. The administrator provides the costs of transit to the place of start (and return) of the winners to the countries of residence.

5.5 During the final stage of the competition, as well as during the trip (the Main Prize) and during the Sziget Festival in Budapest on August 8-15, 2018, the Finalists and Laureates will be accompanied by the Camera. Participants agree to use their image for public distribution via the Internet, reproduction and preservation by any technique, with the right to grant sub-licenses. The consent is granted for an indefinite period, on the territory of the Republic of Poland and the states forming the European Union.

5.6 Participants of the Competition, for the purposes of conducting the contest and implementation of the Main Prize, provide the Organizer with personal data (name, surname, date of birth, address of residence, e-mail address, series and identity card number or passport) by completing the competition form and agreeing to the processing and administration of this data by the Administrator.

5.7 Personal data posted by participants in forms are treated as confidential and are not visible to unauthorized persons.

5.8 Personal data is processed in accordance with the laws on the protection of personal data, to the extent and for the purpose necessary to conduct the Competition and fulfill the obligations by the Organizer; to the extent and for the purpose necessary to fulfill legitimate interests (legitimate purposes), and the processing does not violate the rights and freedoms of the data subject; to the extent and for the purpose consistent with the consent expressed by the Competition Participants and its Laureates.

5.9 Every participant has the right to access their data, rectify, delete or limit processing, the right to object, the right to submit a complaint to the supervisory authority.

5.10 Contact with the person supervising the processing of personal data in the Administrator's organization is possible via e-mail: office@theproduction.pl.

5.11 The Administrator reserves the right to process Participant's data after the end of the Competition or withdrawal of consent only in the scope of seeking possible claims before the court or if national or EU regulations or international law oblige to retention the data.

5.12 The Administrator has the right to share personal data of the Participants of the Competition and its other data to entities authorized under the applicable law (for example law enforcement authorities).

5.13 The removal of personal data may take place as a result of the withdrawal of consent or filing a legally admissible objection to the processing of personal data.

5.14 The administrator does not share personal data with entities other than those authorized on the basis of applicable law.

5.15 The Administrator has implemented pseudonymisation, data encryption and we have introduced access control, thanks to which we minimize the effects of a possible breach of data security.

5.16 Personal data is processed by persons authorized only by the Administrator.

6. ADMINISTRATOR'S RESPONSIBILITY

6.1 The Administrator is not responsible for the inconvenience that arose during the implementation of the Award and for the impossibility of implementation resulting from reasons beyond his control, for example: state decisions, force majeure or circumstances attributable to the Participant.

6.2 The Administrator will not refund the value of the benefits that have not been partly or fully used due to reasons attributable to the Participant, such as, for example, shortening the Event, resignation from some or all of the Event.

7. FINAL PROVISIONS

7.1 In matters not covered by these Regulations, the regulations of Polish law shall apply.

7.2 The administrator reserves the right to change the Competition Regulations if it does not affect the acquired rights of participants taking part in the Competition.
